In order to receive a complete grade you must:

1. Reference the reading(s) for that week and chose something that struck you as important, confusing or most significant.
2. Discuss a scene or scenes you think are significant in some way
3. Relate the films to the reading
4. Come up with thought provoking critical questions. You are welcome to combine your commentary to include the relationship between film and reading or to record your critical responses to both separately **as long as they are in-line with the guiding or topic of the week.**

Please refrain from stating whether or not the viewing and/or reading was 'good' or 'bad'/ worthwhile or worthless. Please also refrain from judging the quality of each other's posts.

Once you have met these requirements, your possible maximum grade is 4.0. This means with every item you miss, you miss a full grade point. For example should you neglect to list your two critical questions, rather than a full 4.0 you will receive a 3.0 and so it goes.

Please keep in mind, anything lower than a 2.0 in this class is considered a failing grade. There is no difference between 1.9 and 0.
