FISD Dual Credit Advantage Program is broken into three levels of commitment. We ask our students/parents to choose one of the levels as they start thinking about taking dual credit courses. The number of total courses/credit hours is calculated over the student's high school career. Dual Credit courses are two class periods, and usually Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday. We recommend that students take a minimum of 2 dual credit courses a semester.
