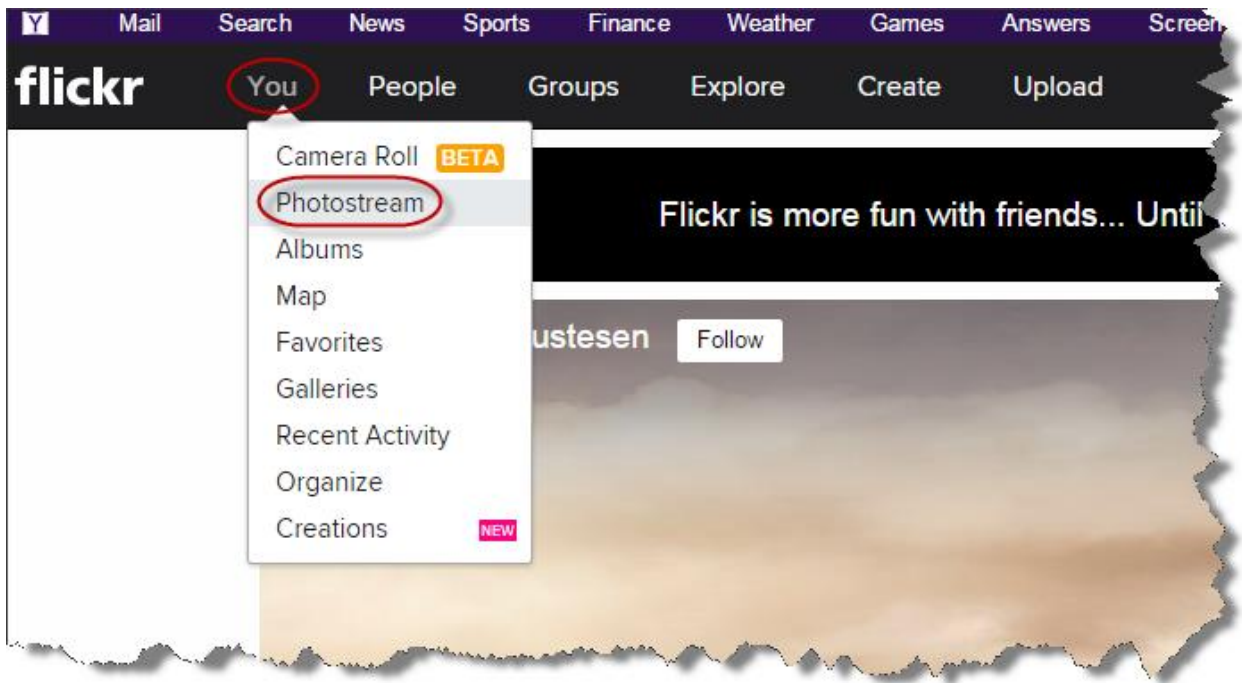


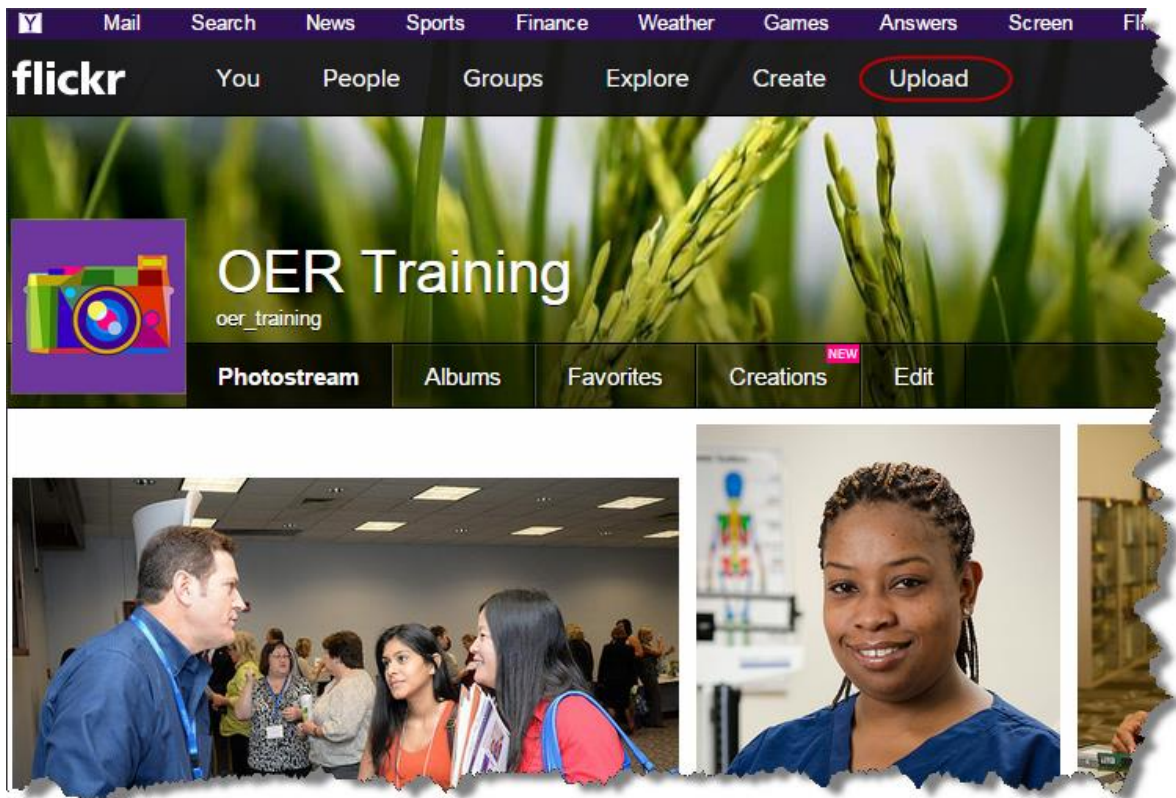
How to upload an image to your Flickr account and mark it with a CC license

1. Go to <http://www.flickr.com/>
2. Click Sign in on the right corner of the screen.
3. Sign in with your username and password.
4. Click **You** and choose **Photostream**.



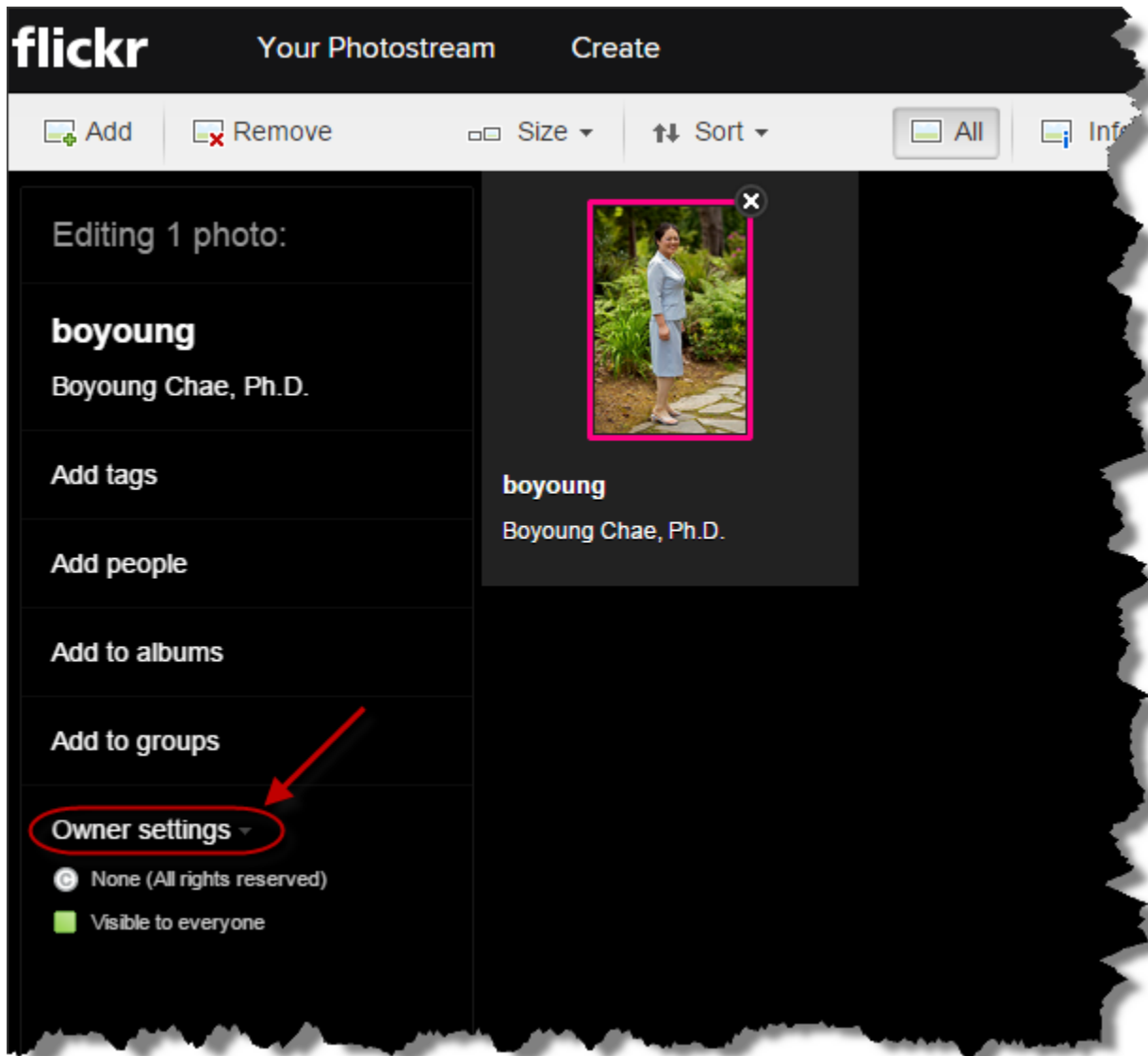
5. You will be taken to your Photostream.

6. To upload an image, click Upload.

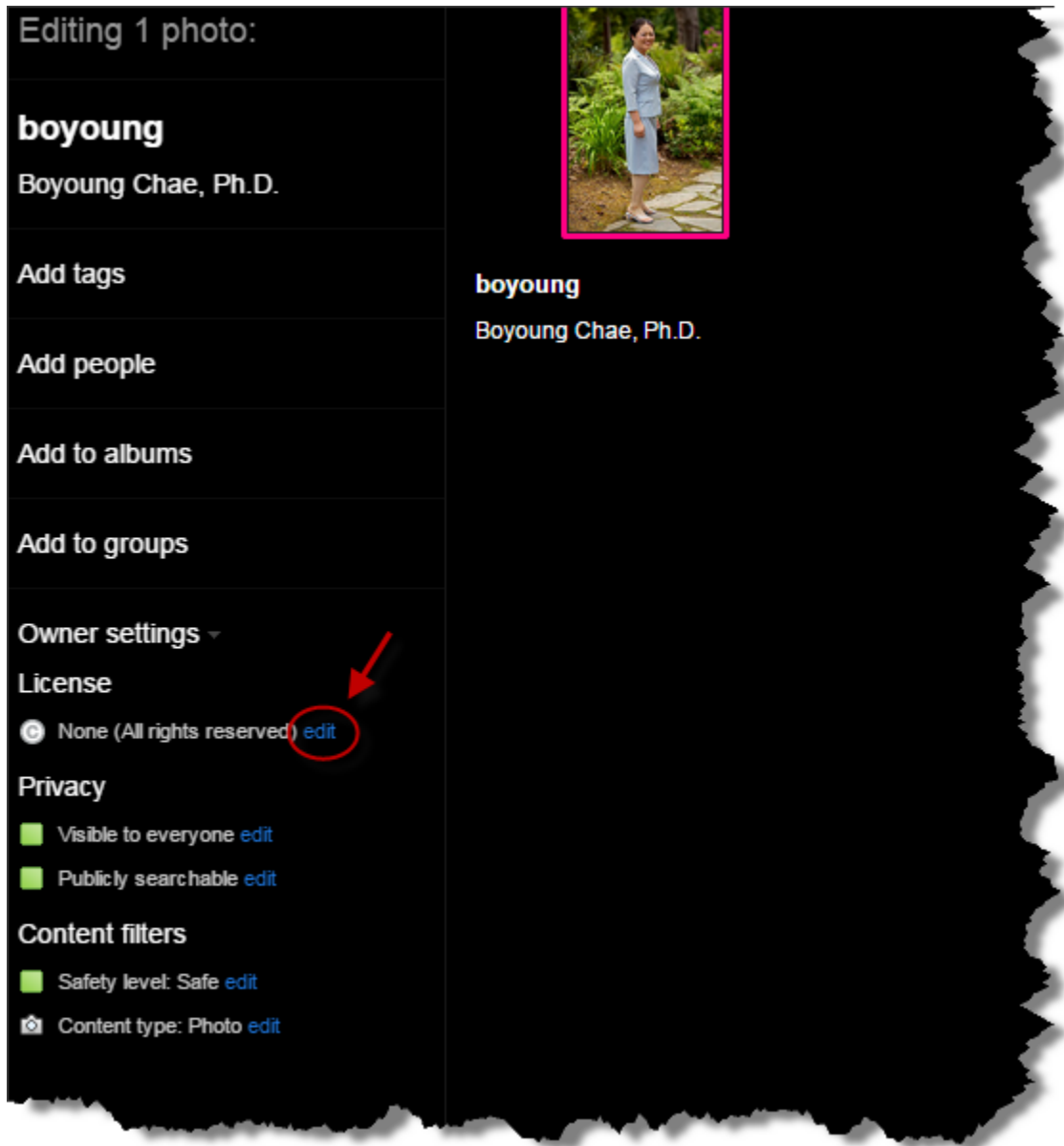


7. Click Choose photos and videos, and upload the picture from your computer. Or simply drag and drop the image file.

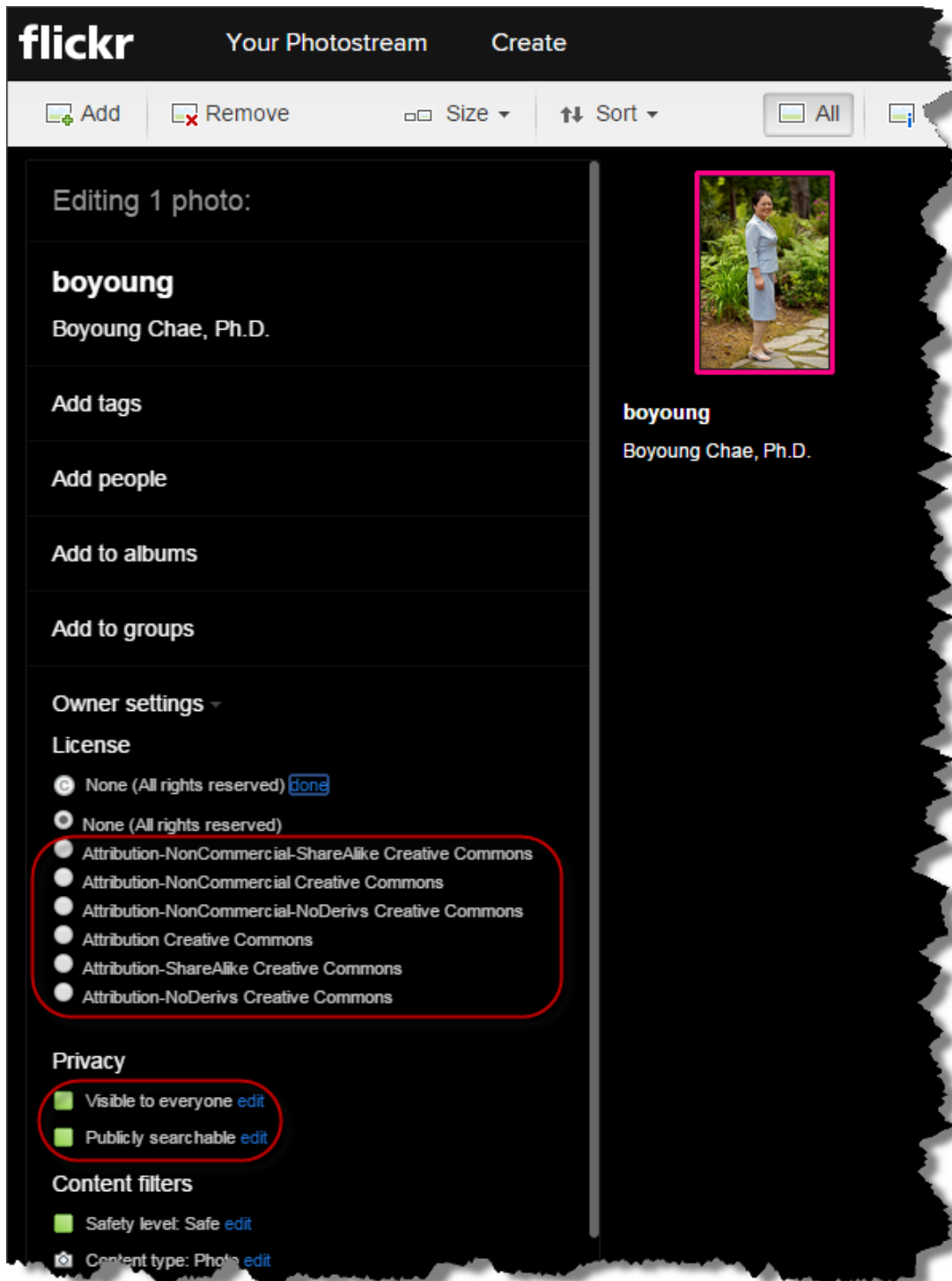
8. Once you finish uploading your image, you will be taken to the Flickr Photostream page where you can edit your picture. Click the upside-down triangle icon located next to the **Owner settings**.



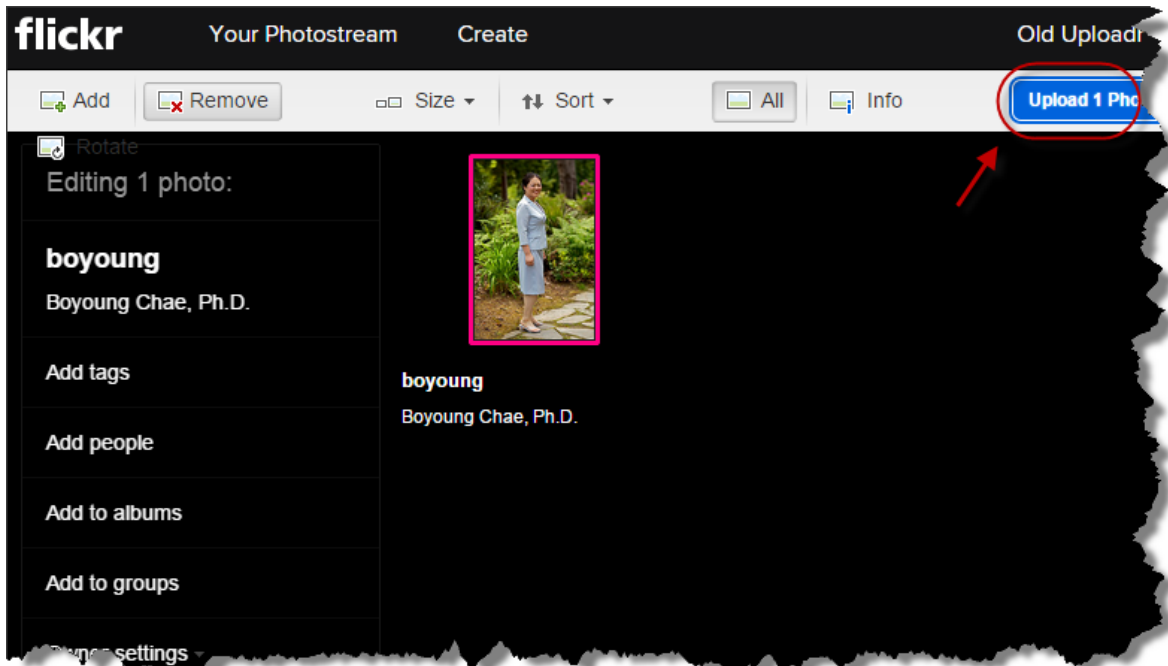
9. Click **edit** link next to **License** sign.



10. Among radio buttons, click a CC license of your choice. Also choose **Visible** and **Searchable** options for **Privacy**. You are encouraged to add a description or tags here, such as course title or your name. Click done when finished.



11. Once you finish editing, click **Upload 1 photo** button on the right top of the screen. You can select **upload** this image or **continue editing** it.



12. If you want to edit your photo after your photo is successfully uploaded to Flickr, please go back to Photo stream and click Edit button.



13. You will be taken to the page where you can make edits to each image.
