To do this ...	In Blackboard, you did this ...	In Canvas, try this ...
Upload your syllabus	Go to a content area (i.e. Course Documents) > Build Content > Item	Use the Syllabus and Edit the Syllabus Description with text and/or an attached file
Add course readings	Go to a content area (i.e. Course Documents) > Build Content > Item	Use Modules or Pages to share course materials, such as readings, with students
Add a link	Go to a content area (i.e. Course Documents) > Build Content > URL	Add a link to a Page or an external link to a Module
Organize content	Within a folder: Drag and drop Within a content area: Create folders	Use Modules or linked Pages to create a hierarchical structure to your course site
Create assignments	Go to a content area (i.e. Assignments) > Create Assessment > Assignment	Go to Assignments > Add Assignment
Download student submissions	Under the Grade Center column for the assignment	On the Assignment page for the assignment
Add a blog or wiki to your site	Go to a content area (i.e. Assignments) > Add Interactive Tool	Go to Assignments > Add Assignment and create an assignment with the type “ External Tool ” Go to Modules > Add Content > Add External Tool
Build a quiz	Go to a content area (i.e. Assignments) > Create Assessment > Test	Go to Quizzes > Create New Quiz
View student grades	In the Control Panel, Grade Center > Full Grade Center	Go to Grades
View course roster	In the Control Panel, Users and Groups > Users	Go to People
Edit the course navigation	Edit content area names and add/reorder content areas and tool links in the course menu	Go to Settings > Navigation to rearrange and show/hide menu options
Change the course home page	In the Control Panel, Customization > Style > Select Course Entry Point	On the course home page, Change Course Home Page Layout
Send an email message to the class	Tools > Send Email	Click on Inbox to send a message to the class or use your Class List provided by ISC (more info)
